■ IB Workshop - Well-being and Student Leadership, Cat 3 CONTINUUM

This IB workshop on well-being and student leadership provides schools with a framework to audit their practices on well-being and student leadership, lead advisory groups to inform the decision making process, and continually review expectations, capabilities, feedback, motivation, and opportunities with the school community. This workshop is built around school leaders across the continuum and looks at all areas of well-being when considering school design: spiritual, social, emotional, cognitive. and physical.

This workshop also gives school leaders the tools to develop, plan, and implement an inclusive whole school well-being program. Participants will gain a shared understanding of the different forms of well-being and reflect on a whole-school approach in their current school context using a plus, minus, interesting (PMI) analysis and a self-reflection survey. Participants will further develop an understanding of restorative practices in schools, the benefits of working as a community, and the use of a positive behaviours framework. Strategies for community engagement will be covered, including developing advisory groups (staff, parents, and students) and sharing strategies for working with parents and community members. Finally, participants will consider the common understandings and definitions about bullying and cyber bullying and explore research-based best practices for helping students who experience this type of behaviour.
