Pam is Director of Professional Development at Fieldwork Education. She previously worked in schools and local authorities in England and now works with school worldwide.

Pam has written several books and articles focusing on practical aspects of leadership and management and curriculum development. She led one of the writing teams for the International Primary Curriculum and has provided leadership training and consultancy at summer schools, conferences and international schools throughout the world. She is project director for the International Leadership and Management Program for senior and middle leaders – our learning focused leadership programs developed along with our partner organization of ECIS (European Council of International Schools) and NAHT (National Association of Head Teachers).

Workshop Description

This will include the collection, analysis and use of evidence about learning and leading and managing learning focused teams and meetings.

- Have increased your knowledge and skills regarding leading learning focused teams and managing learning focused meetings
